

What will I do if I'm a mentor?

You will work one-on-one with a child that has been assigned to you. We ask that you set aside 30 minutes to one hour a week to spend quality time with your mentee at school. Most students in the Mentor Program just need guidance or a role model to help them reach their full potential. You will get to know your mentee by playing games, helping them with their schoolwork and lending a supportive ear when they need one. Some mentees may have a deployed parent, come from a single parent home or just need extra attention from an adult. You don't have to have kids of your own to be a mentor, just the willingness to make a difference in the life of a child.
